Impact of the 2024 Noto Peninsula Earthquake on our business activities

We would like to express our condolences to those who lost their lives in the 2024 Noto Peninsula Earthquake, and our deepest sympathies to those who have been affected by the disaster.

Nikkiso has set up a joint disaster response headquarters at its head office and Kanazawa Plant, and is continuing to gather information, respond and consider countermeasures.

Nikkiso hereby announces that it has decided when production will resume at the Kanazawa Plant (3-1, Hokuyodai, Kanazawa, Ishikawa Prefecture) and the Hakusan Plant (1-5-1, Asahigaoka, Hakusan, Ishikawa Prefecture), which have suspended operations due to minor damage to the buildings.

■ Kanazawa Plant (Medical-Equipment Manufacturing Base)

- We have confirmed that there are no operational problems and production will resume on 9 January.
- There are no problems with the supply of dialysis machines, dialysate, dialyzers and other supplies.

■ Hakusan Factory (Deep UV LEDs Development Base)

- We plan to gradually resume production over the next week, while confirming the safety of the equipment.
- There are no problems with the supply of products related to deep UV LEDs.
